

[Guidelines for 2026 Global Korea Scholarship Alumni Invitation Program]

- **Program Period:** November 1 ~ November 8, 2026 (8 days and 7 nights)
- **Number of Participants:** 15 GKS alumni from around the world
- **Program Details (Subject to change):** workshops, industry visits, cultural activities, GKS bridge project (self-planned visits) and etc.
- **Benefits:**
 - An economy class round-trip air ticket
 - Participant will need to buy air ticket him/herself and later get reimbursed based on the pertinent receipt upon arrival in Seoul.
 - When transit is necessary, purchasing the ticket itinerary with the shortest route, minimum price and time is needed in order to get reimbursed.
 - Expenses related to the program, including accommodations, meals and daily activity fees

Attention! Participants must bear the following costs by themselves: the transportation expenses incurred in the invitee's country, visa application fees, and all other personal expenses not related to the invitation program.

- **Presentation on Post-GKS Career Development (Workshop I)**
 - All participants will make a presentation on their career/activities after GKS, Please submit the presentation materials as guided below.
 - Format: Word document(.doc) or PowerPoint(.ppt)
 - Possible Topics
 - Career life and activities after completing a degree under GKS
 - The impacts of GKS on the professional and personal life
 - Involvement in the GKS Alumni Association in home country

○ **GKS Bridge Project (Self-Planned Visits)**

- Participants will be given two days for their own visits and activities during the program period.
- Participants are advised to plan their own visits and to arrange accommodation/meals for the two days.
- Participants must plan visits to compliment the main purpose of GKS Bridge Project: How can you, as a GKS Alumni, support the partnership between Korea and home country using your career or field that you are in.
- Participants will receive a certain amount of financial support to cover the expenses for accommodation, food, and transportation.
(*You may have to pay for exceeded amount when needed.)

○ **Presentation on GKS Bridge Project and GKS Alumni Invitation Program (Workshop II)**

- All participants will make a presentation on their GKS Bridge Project.
- Format: Word document(.doc) or PowerPoint(.ppt)
- Topics
 - Brief explanation of GKS Bridge project and result: current and future plans.
 - Share personal impression or thoughts about this GKS Alumni invitation program.
